

# ***Directions for Driving to Berriedale Farms***

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## **Highway Directions from the Washington Metropolitan Area:**

- (1) Interstate Route 66 west about 65 miles to the end.
- (2) Interstate Route 81 south past Harrisonburg toward Staunton.
- (3) Exit 225 at Route 262 "Monterey" west for 5.5 miles. Note that this is the last opportunity for cell phone connections.
- (4) Follow U.S. Route 250 west (right) through Churchville and over Shenandoah Mountain for 25.5 miles. Note that you will pass Mountain View Store on the left between Churchville and Shenandoah Mountain, and this will be the last place to buy gasoline or food.
- (5) Turn left on Lower Fork Road or State Route 616 just before Headwaters and drive four miles. Later left again, on the Cowpasture River Road South or State Route 614, 2<sup>nd</sup> drive on gravel for seven miles.
- (6) Cross a 200-foot-long bridge over the Cowpasture River and drive another 0.2 miles. Note a street sign "Berriedale Road" on near end of the bridge.
- (7) A dark blue farm gate with the number 10245, American wire fence and the Berriedale Farm house will be on the left.

## **Highway Directions from the Roanoke Area and Points South:**

- (1) Interstate Route 81 north from Blacksburg/Roanoke or Interstate Route 64 west from Richmond to Lexington.
- (2) At Lexington, take Interstate Route 64 west one exit to U.S. Route 11.
- (3) Take U.S. Route 11 north for one-tenth (0.1) of a mile.
- (4) Turn left on Virginia Route 39 west and drive 19.9 miles through Goshen.
- (5) Continue on Virginia Routes 39 and 42 west 8.0 miles to Millboro Springs.
- (6) Continue west on Virginia Route 39 for another six-tenths (0.6) of a mile to Virginia Route 678.
- (7) Turn right onto Virginia Route 678 and drive 16.7 miles to Williamsville.
- (8) In Williamsville, turn right onto Virginia Route 614 or the Cowpasture River Road, drive across the Bullpasture River and northeast for 2.8 miles.
- (9) On the right there will be a blue farm gate with the number 10245 and an American wire fence – that is our entrance.

## **Highway Directions from the Richmond (Virginia) Metropolitan Area:**

- (1) Interstate Route 64 WEST for 100 miles to I-81 near Staunton.
- (2) Interstate I-81 SOUTH for one (1) mile to Exit 220 and Virginia Route 262.
- (3) Virginia Route 262 WEST and NORTH for seven (7) miles to U.S. Route 250.
- (4) U.S. Route 250 WEST or left through Churchville and over Shenandoah Mountain switchbacks at 3,000 feet for 25 miles to Head Waters.
- (5) Note that Churchville will be the last opportunity for cell phone connections.

- (6) Note further that you will pass Mountain View Store on the left between Churchville and Shenandoah Mountain, and this will be the last place to buy gasoline.
- (7) Turn left onto State Route 616 SOUTH just before Head Waters (i.e., one church and a general store, don't blink) and drive for four miles. Turn LEFT again, on the Cowpasture River Road SOUTH or State Route 614 and drive on gravel for seven miles.
- (8) Cross a 200-foot-long concrete bridge over the Cowpasture River and drive another 0.2 miles. Note street sign "Berriedale Road" at the near end of the bridge.
- (9) A dark blue farm gate numbered 10245, an American wire fence and the barn, garage and house will be on the left.

### **Highway Directions from Southeastern West Virginia:**

- (1) Interstate Route 64 east to Covington, Virginia.
- (2) At Covington, take the exit for U.S. Route 220 north.
- (3) Drive north on Route 220 through Covington, through Hot Springs, past Virginia Route 39, proceed another approximately four and a half miles total, past County Route 621, and at the bottom of a hill slide right on County Route 614 to Burnsville.
- (4) Drive 14.3 miles from U.S. Route 220 along County Route 614 to Williamsville – be cautious along Route 614 because there are many sharp, blind curves and no guard rails.
- (5) At the stop sign in Burnsville, continue straight on County Route 614.
- (6) At the stop sign in Williamsville, turn right for another 500 feet.
- (7) At the bridge in Williamsville, turn left again on County Route 614 or the Cowpasture River Road and proceed northeast for 2.8 miles.
- (8) On the right there will be a blue farm gate with the number 10245 and an American wire fence – that is our entrance.

### **Highway Directions from Highland & Pendleton Counties:**

- (1) From Franklin in West Virginia, drive south along U.S. Route 220 to Monterey, Virginia.
- (2) In Monterey, turn left or east on U.S. Route 250 to McDowell, Virginia.
- (3) In McDowell and in front of the Presbyterian Church, turn right or south and drive 13.9 miles along County Route 678 to Williamsville.
- (4) At the stop sign in Williamsville continue straight for another 500 feet.
- (5) At the bridge in Williamsville, turn left on County Route 614 or the Cowpasture River Road and proceed northeast for 2.8 miles.
- (6) On the right there will be a blue farm gate with the number 10245 and an American wire fence – that is our entrance.
